

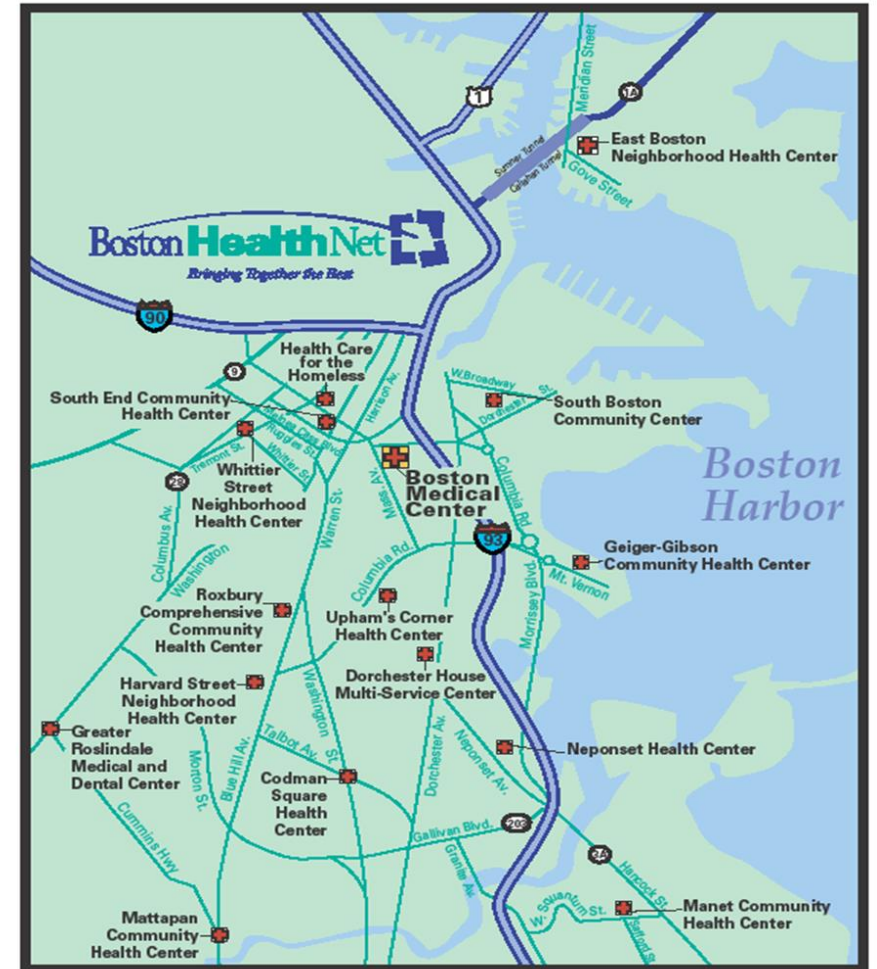

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Patient Navigation in Boston ‘post-PNRP’

- **Boston PNRP:** navigation in 1 health system reduced delays diagnosis, treatment
- Navigation programs develop independently across each health system in Boston (n=6)
- Regional navigator meetings, but wide variability in navigation models and no ‘sharing’ of patient level information
- 2014* Black:White disparities breast cancer in Boston among worst in country.....



The Boston Breast Cancer Equity Coalition

- A **multidisciplinary group** of stakeholders convened in 2014: Nonprofits, government agencies, institutions that provide care, patients, advocates, policy makers, researchers
- **Share a common goal:** To eliminate differences in breast cancer outcomes by promoting equity and excellence in care among all women in Boston.
- **Approach:** develop city-wide solutions with the specific goal of eliminating the inequities in breast outcomes that exist among Black, non-Hispanic women in Boston

*TRIP: Translating Research into Practice**

- *A Dissemination and Implementation Science study*
- To improve the delivery of timely, quality breast cancer care among vulnerable patients in Boston through a coordinated care delivery model that includes:
 - (a) A Patient Navigation network
 - (b) A shared patient registry
 - (c) Screening and referral platform for SDOH

Goal = to eliminate care delivery disparities and serve as model for other locations and other diseases.
