• These relationships have the greatest impact on how people make decisions, develop habits





Expected changes to clinical trials



- 1. Invest in building longitudinal relationships
 - Identify CBOs with which to build relationships
- 2. Build trust
 - Commit only what you can really do
 - Be prepared to pay for access
- 3. Come to the community well before recruitment is needed
 - Be there, at least, months before the identified need
 - Collaborate with existing efforts
 - If you do any "one time only" events you will lose all credibility
