


## CAPITAL REGION



- One of 14 local workforce areas in Virginia created by and funded under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
- Business-led Workforce Development Board sets policy framework for strategic deployment of resources to assist businesses and jobseekers.
- Convenes a network of government and community-based partners to streamline workforce services and supports.
- Operates three regional workforce centers that welcomed nearly 30,000 visitors in the most recent fiscal year.
- Outcomes for jobseekers exiting services:
  - Job Placement 85%
  - Job Retention 80%
  - Credential Attainment 75%



- •40,674 job posts in the region past 30 days
- •8,300 distinct employers posting those jobs
- •716 different occupation types
- •466 unique certifications related to those posts


