- One of 14 local workforce areas in Virginia created by and funded under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
- Business-led Workforce Development Board sets policy framework for strategic deployment of resources to assist businesses and jobseekers.
- Convenes a network of government and community-based partners to streamline workforce services and supports.
- Operates three regional workforce centers that welcomed nearly 30,000 visitors in the most recent fiscal year.
- Outcomes for jobseekers exiting services:
 - Job Placement – 85%
 - Job Retention – 80%
 - Credential Attainment – 75%



- **40,674** job posts in the region past 30 days
- **8,300** distinct employers posting those jobs
- **716** different occupation types
- **466** unique certifications related to those posts

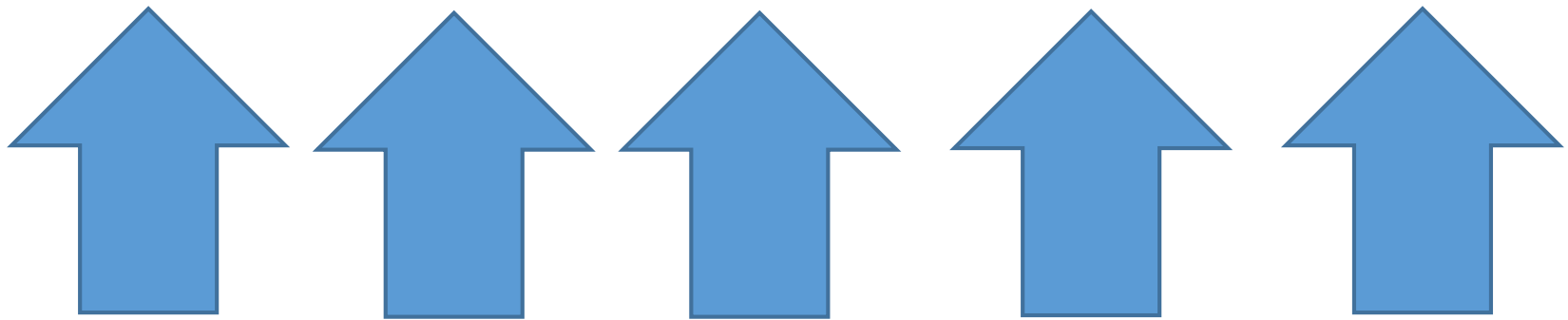

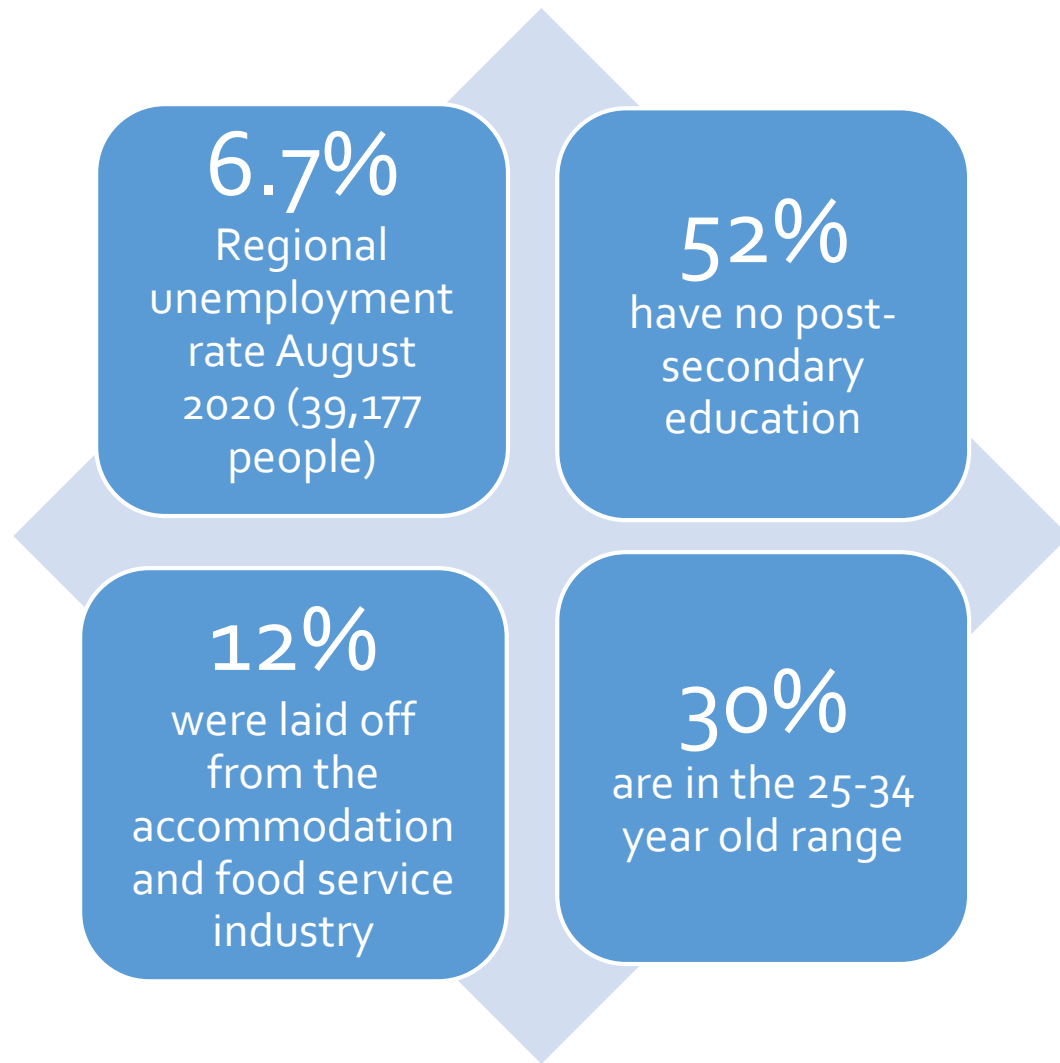
