Key Data Points We Track

Impact on LMHA services:

Approximately 7% of 988 calls receive a referral to a LMHA

Impact on Emergency Services:

Less than 2% of 988 calls require an emergent response

Comparison to LMHA Community Crisis Lines:

No decrease in LMHA volume, some centers experiencing increases

Likelihood of Caller Accepting Referral

8% of 988 callers

32% of LMHA Community Crisis Line callers
